County Committee Organizer's Toolkit

This toolkit provides practical guidance for establishing and operating a county central committee for a newly recognized political party in Missouri.

1. Committee Formation

- Recruit at least two committed members to serve as officers (Chair, Treasurer).
- Hold an organizing meeting to adopt temporary rules.
- File necessary paperwork with the Missouri Ethics Commission.

2. Roles and Responsibilities

- Chair: Leads meetings, represents the committee publicly.
- Vice Chair: Assists Chair and fills in when absent.
- Treasurer: Handles finances, files required MEC reports.
- Secretary: Keeps minutes, manages correspondence.

3. Building Membership

- Connect with existing grassroots organizations in your county.
- Host informational meetings and outreach events.
- Maintain an up-to-date membership list.

4. Fundraising and Compliance

- Organize small-dollar fundraisers like dinners, raffles, or online donation drives.
- Record all contributions and expenditures for MEC compliance.
- File timely reports to maintain good standing.

5. Coordinating with the State Party

- Participate in state conventions and leadership meetings.
- Share information about local candidates and issues.
- Align messaging with state party goals while maintaining local autonomy.

6. Election Readiness

- Recruit and train poll watchers.
- Support vetted candidates for local offices.
- Coordinate get-out-the-vote efforts.
